We have previously received unanimous support from Merrickville-Wolford Municipal Council, the Chamber of Commerce, the Recreation Advisory Committee and the Rideau Community Health Services, which includes the Merrickville District Community Health Centre.

The goal of Run Merrickville is to encourage participation in a running/walking event open to all ages and levels of physical fitness.
